Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What time should I arrive at the cruise terminal?

Always follow the arrival time assigned by your cruise line. Arriving much earlier may result in waiting outside the terminal, while arriving late could delay your boarding process.

Q: Can I access my stateroom immediately?

Not always. Many cruise lines open staterooms in the early afternoon after the crew has finished preparing them. Plan to keep your carry-on with you until your room is available.

Q: When will my luggage arrive?

Most checked luggage is delivered within a few hours after boarding. Occasionally it may arrive later in the afternoon, so pack anything you'll need before then in your carry-on bag.

Q: Should I complete the muster drill right away?

Yes. Completing the required safety drill early allows you to enjoy the rest of embarkation day without having to interrupt your activities later.

Q: Can I use the ship's Wi-Fi immediately?

In most cases, yes. Once onboard, connect to the ship's Wi-Fi and use the cruise line's app to access daily schedules, deck maps, dining reservations, and other helpful information.

Q: What's the best advice for first-time cruisers?

Relax and enjoy the experience. Embarkation day is exciting, and there is no need to rush. Complete the important tasks first, then take time to explore, have lunch, and celebrate the beginning of your vacation.
