Cruise Travel Documents

Essential Cruise Travel Documents

Document	Why You Need It
Passport or Other Accepted ID	Required identification for your itinerary.
Cruise Boarding Documents	Required to check in and board your ship.
Flight Confirmations	Useful for airline check-in and travel changes.
Hotel Reservations	Proof of accommodations before or after your cruise.
Travel Insurance	Policy details and emergency contact numbers.
Excursion Confirmations	Helps verify pre-booked tours.
Emergency Contacts	Important if unexpected situations arise.

Keep Both Printed and Digital Copies

Technology is helpful, but batteries die and internet access is not always available. Carry printed copies of your most important travel documents while also storing secure digital copies on your phone or in cloud storage. Having both options provides valuable peace of mind.

Organize Before You Leave Home

Keep your passport, cruise documents, airline confirmations, hotel reservations, travel insurance information, and excursion tickets together in a travel organizer. Never place important travel documents in checked luggage.

Aimee's Pro Tip

A few days before departure, I encourage my clients to do one final document check. Verify that every traveler has the correct identification, boarding documents, insurance information, and emergency contacts before leaving for the airport. A few minutes of preparation can save hours of stress.
